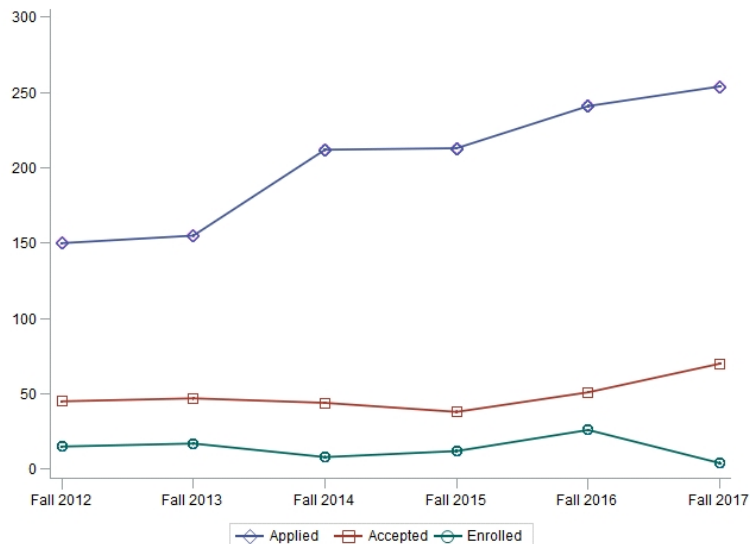

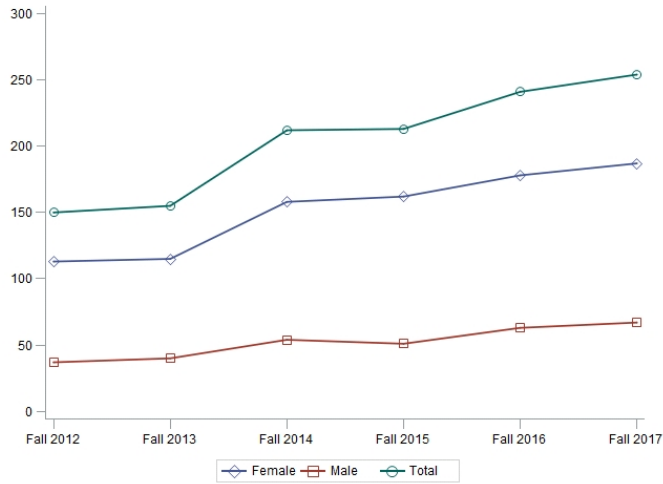
**Applied, Accepted, and Enrolled for First-Time Freshmen Programs by Term**

**Fiscal Year 2013 to 2018**

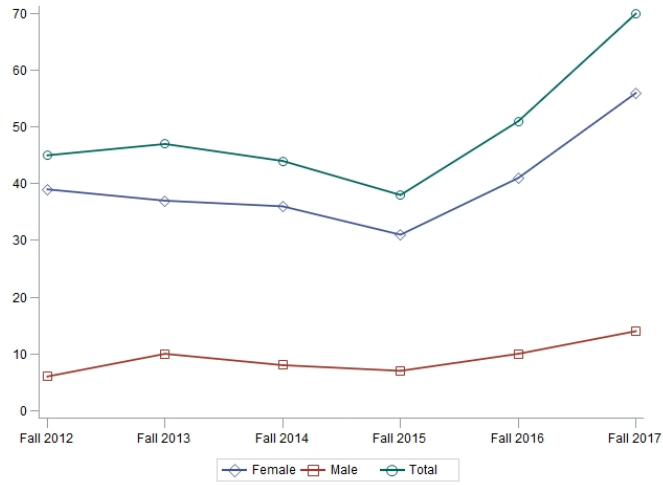

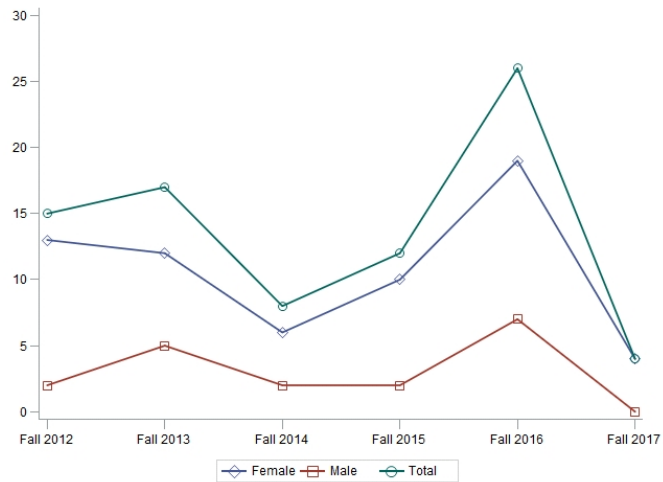
**First-Time Freshmen Applicants by Gender and Term**

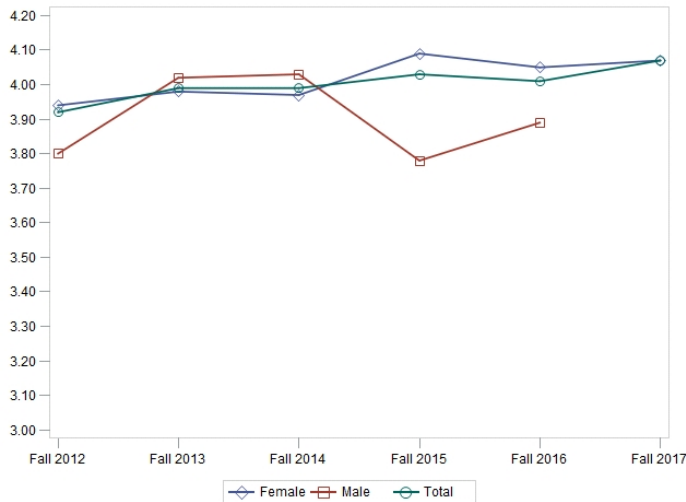

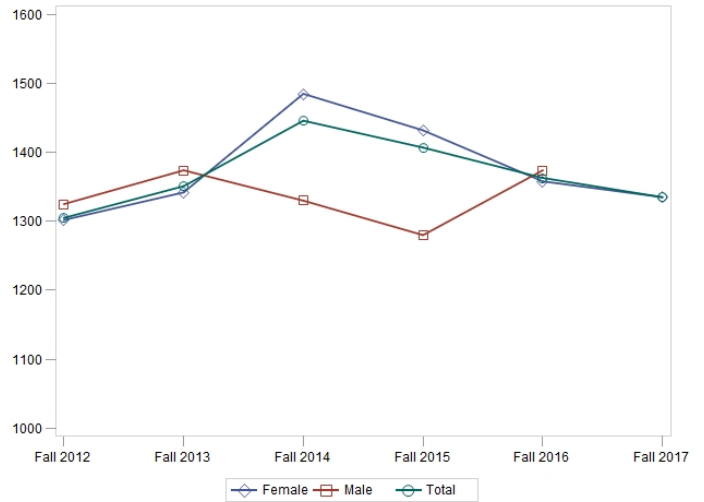

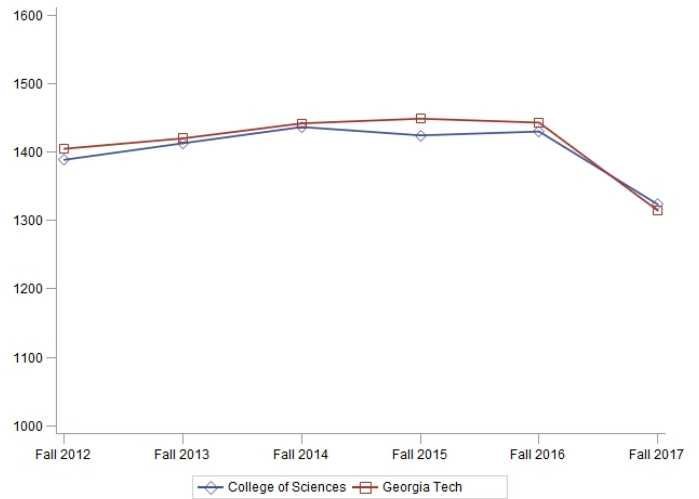

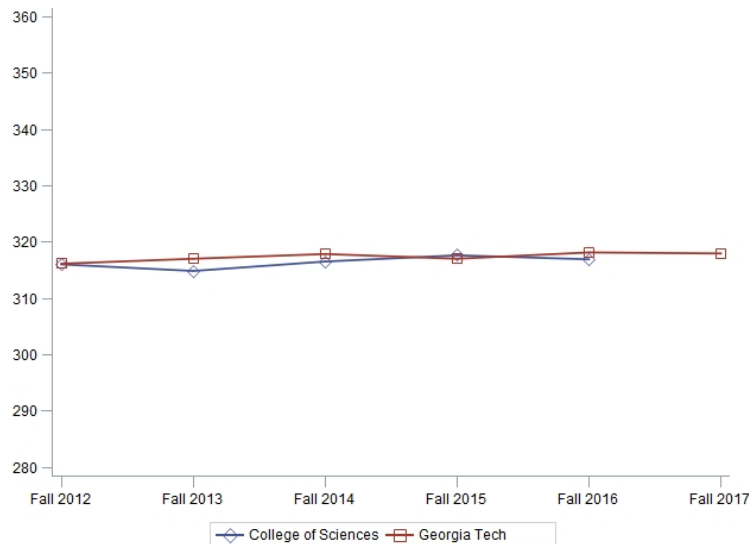

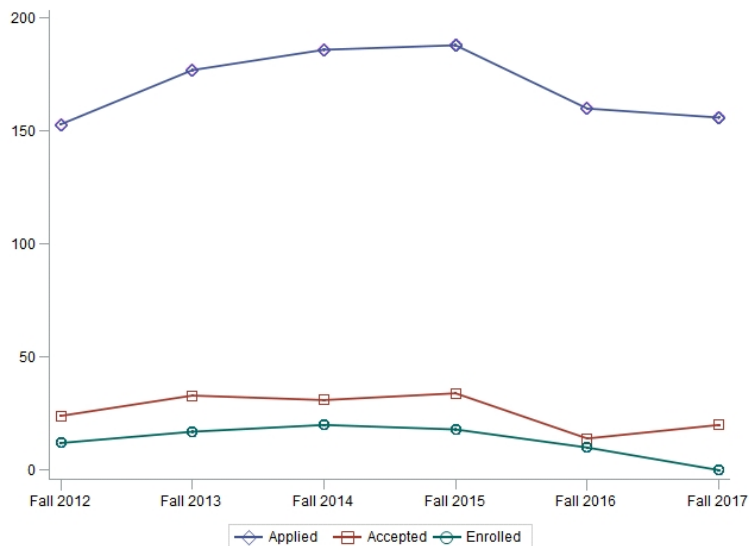

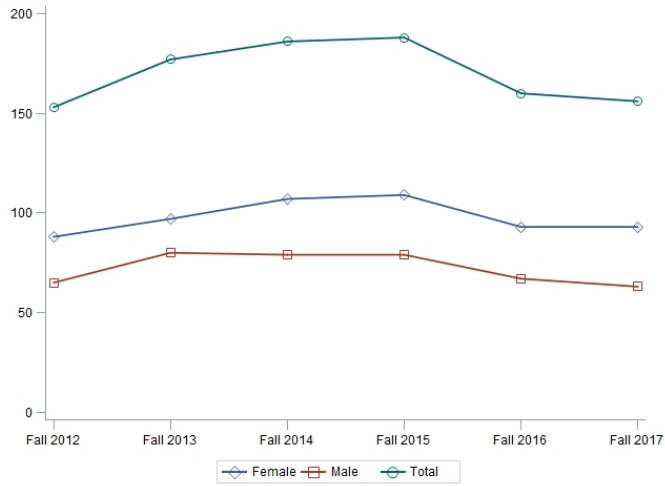

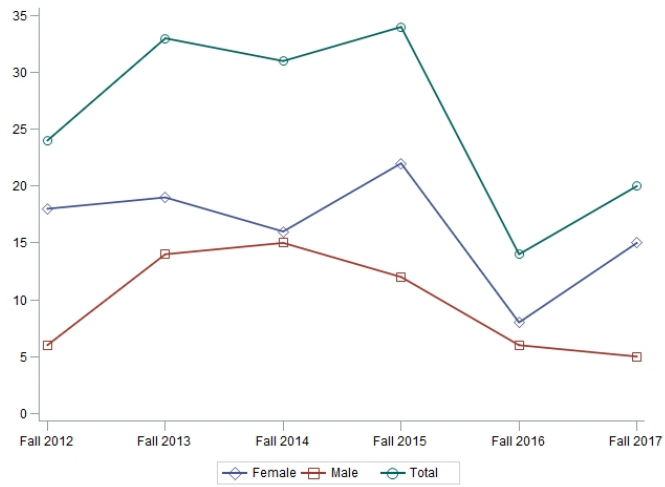

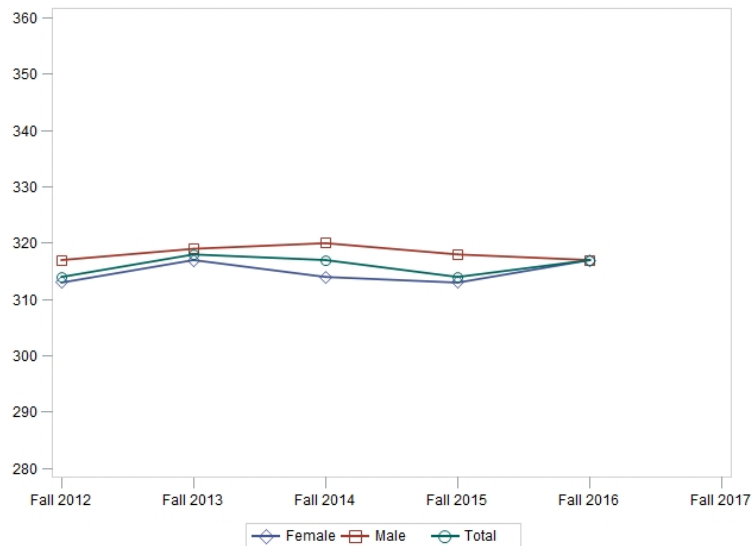

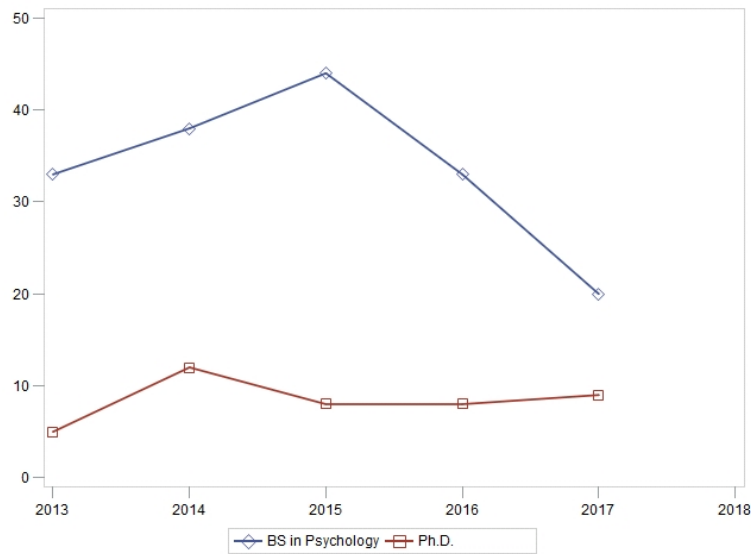

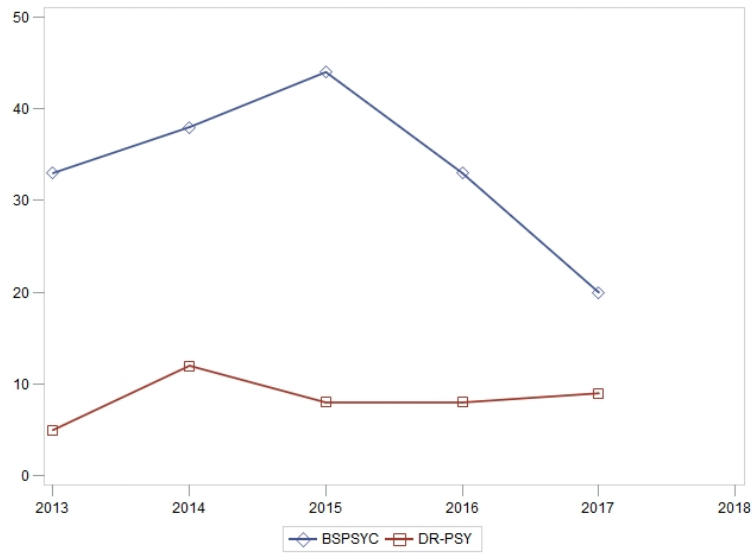

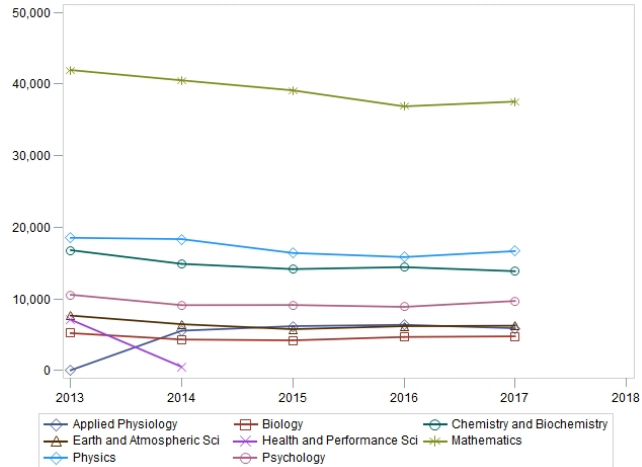

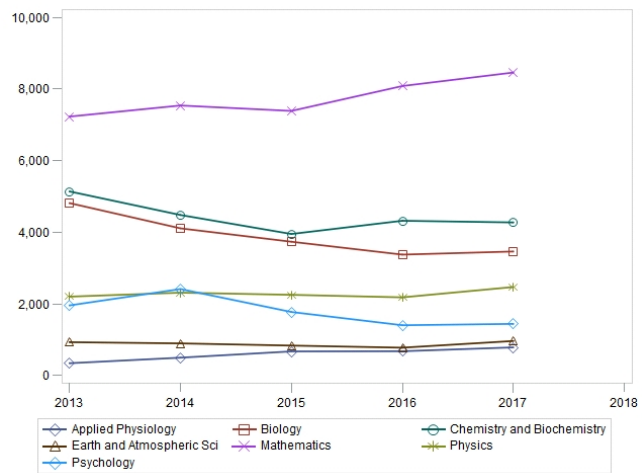


**Semester Credit Hours by Level**

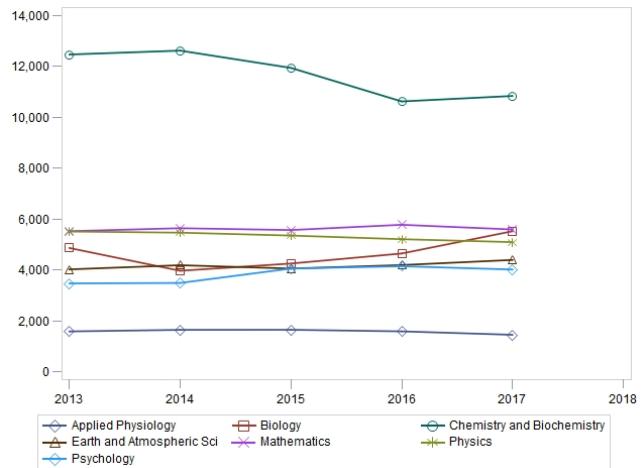

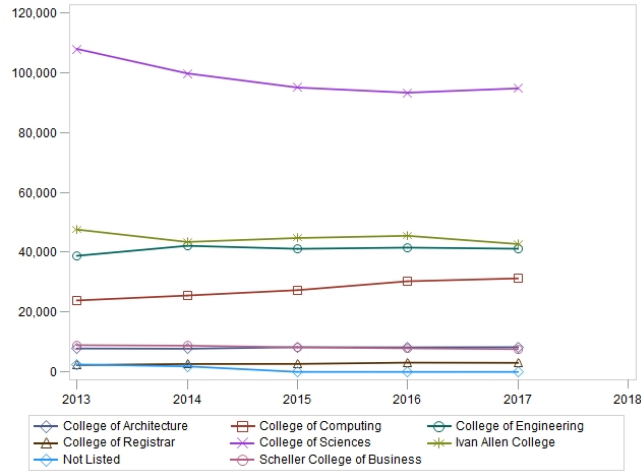

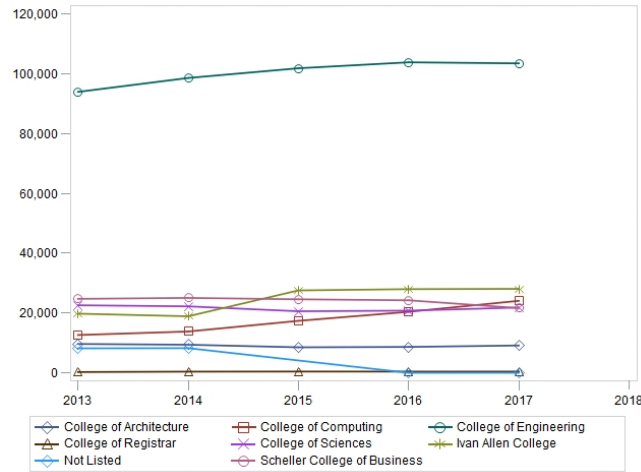

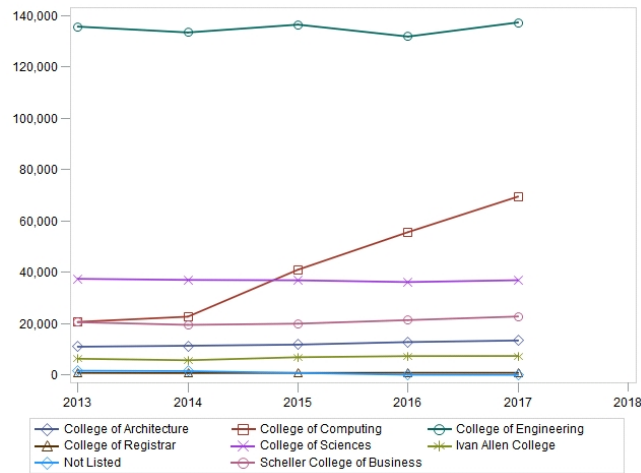
